Clinic Philosophy

The Bengal Youth Baseball Clinic is a fundamental skills clinic. The main goal of the youth clinic is to teach basic batting, pitching, base running and fielding techniques including throwing and catching. These skills are taught in stations and players will be rotated through to each of the stations. Each station will be run by a high school coach or player who plays that particular position or who excels at hitting for the batting stations.

Clinic Format

Players are divided up into two grade levels (3rd-5th & 6th-9th grade) and will participate in two separate sessions. The 3rd-5th graders will participate from 1:30-3:00 P.M. and the 6th-9th graders will participate from 3:15-4:45 P.M. In each session players will be grouped primarily with players in their same grade. All players will have an opportunity to participate in each of the stations.
